# \$50,000 SETTLEMENT OBTAINED FOR WOMAN SPIED ON IN A FITTING ROOM

Bailey Law Firm has announced that it has secured a \$50,000 settlement on behalf of a woman whose privacy was violated when a Peeping Tom photographed her with a cell phone in her dressing room at a big box retailer. The perpetrator placed his phone beneath the door of the dressing room, took photographs and then fled the scene. He was never identified or caught, but the woman suffered from emotional distress and harm as a result.

Attorney Tyler D. Bailey has stated that this case shows how important it is for businesses to ensure the safety of their customers. He has prepared the following statement regarding the settlement secured.

“This case is important because far too often business owners attempt to evade any responsibility when third parties commit crimes that harm their patrons despite having knowledge that their patrons are at risk,” he stated further “Results like this demonstrate that business and property owners can be held accountable in South Carolina for crimes committed by third parties that harm victims on their property if it can be established that they knew and/or should have known that they created an unreasonable risk of harm the victim suffered.”

The names of the parties involved in this case are being withheld to protect their confidentiality.

Attorney Tyler D. Bailey was recently appointed by City Council to serve as a Commissioner on the City of Columbia Municipal Election Commission.

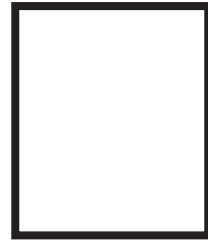
